(27)5:Or else let him take hold of my strength, that he may make peace with me; yes, let him make peace with me.

6:In days to come shall Yaakov take root; Yisrael shall blossom and bud; and they shall fill the surface of the world with fruit

with fruit. 7:Like the smiting of him who smote him, did He smite him; like the slaying of his slain ones, was he slain?

8:In measure, when they send him away, You contended with them; He spoke through His harsh blast in the day of the east wind

the east wind.
9:Therefore by this shall the iniquity of Yaakov be forgiven, and this is all the fruit of taking away his sin: by making all the stones of the altar as chalk stones that are beaten in sunder, so that the Asherim and the sun-images shall rise no more.

10:For the fortified city is solitary, a habitation deserted and forsaken, like the wilderness: there shall the calf feed, and there shall he lie down, and consume the branches of it.

11:When the boughs of it are withered, they shall be broken off; the women shall come, and set them on fire; for it is a people of no understanding: therefore its Maker will not have compassion on it, and He who formed it will show it no favor.
